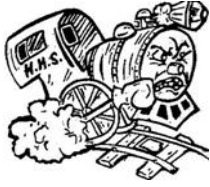

CAMPSITE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SOLAR ECLIPSE OF 2017

August 18th - 21st, 2017

All campsites are located on property owned by the Huntington School District 16J. School District properties are subject to federal, state, county, and local laws. In addition to those laws the Huntington School District 16J creates its own policies and procedures that govern the use of school property.

Campsite rules and regulations:

1. All campsites are assigned randomly on a first come, first serve basis.
2. All campsites are 20' x 20' (TENT ONLY). A small number of campsites locate along the edge of the field may be larger than 20' x 20'.
3. All campsites are TENT ONLY sites.
4. NO VEHICLES will be permitted in the campsite areas.
5. Campsites are \$300.00 for *3 days only. (August 18, 19, & 20, 2017)
 - Friday, August 18, 2017 Check-in starts at 9:00 AM/PST
 - Saturday, August 19, 2017 Visit Pioneer Days downtown or tour Huntington area.
 - Sunday, August 20, 2017 Relax and tour Huntington area.
 - Monday, August 21, 2017 Solar Eclipse Day. Check out by 6:00 PM/PST.
6. *An additional 1 day (August 21, 2017) campsite can be purchased on the website for an additional \$50.00 fee. All campers staying the extra night must check-out August 22, 2017, by 3:00 PM PST.
7. All campsites must be reserved through the Huntington School District website reservation form and payment will only be accepted through PayPal.
8. Once payment has been received you should receive an emailed receipt within 24 hours of your payment being received.
9. Please have a copy of your receipt available upon arrival.
10. All guests must check-in. You will be provided with a *parking permit and your campsite location number tag.
11. **All sales are final once payment has been received. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**
12. All campsites must display the campsite location number tag in a visible location at all times.
13. All campsites are to be kept clean and neat at all times. Dumpsters will be available for garbage.
14. Public urination is illegal and violators will be removed by law enforcement. Portable restrooms will be provided around camping area.
15. **NO OPEN FLAME BURNING ALLOWED.** Burning Bans will be in affect during the Summer
16. Propane cook stoves and lanterns are acceptable.
17. **NO SMOKING** of any kind is allowed on school district property.
18. **NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES** of any kind are allowed on school district property
19. No gas powered equipment will be allowed on campsites.

20. Do not dig holes or remove areas of grass from the field.
21. Keep noise levels at an acceptable level. Respect the others camping around you.
22. The Huntington School District 16J, its employees and students will NOT be responsible for stolen, lost, damaged, or misplaced items or equipment. Secure valuable items in your vehicle and do not leave areas unattended for long periods of time.
23. The Huntington School District 16J is NOT responsible for injuries sustained on school property.
24. Surveillance cameras will be in use during the event.
25. Use of Ariel Drones on school property is prohibited unless approved by a designated district official. Please contact a campsite host who can direct you to the proper district official.
26. Entry into school buildings is strictly prohibited. Buildings WILL NOT be open to the general public. Exceptions will be made for pre-arranged events scheduled open to the public.
27. Special campsite requests and accommodations can be made by emailing the Huntington School District at the email provided on the schools website. The school will do its best to honor the requests of customers but cannot guarantee those requests.

Parking Rules:

Reminder: The City of Huntington is anticipating a large number of people to be in town for the Solar Eclipse. The large number of people may clog streets and leave available parking areas at a minimum. The school has several parking areas that will be reserved for those purchasing campsites at the school. However, these reserve parking areas contain a limited number of spaces and will be offered to those with reserve parking permits on a first come, first serve basis. Reserve Parking Permits are free and having one does not guarantee you a parking space at the school. Local Law Enforcement agencies will be patrolling roads and side streets for parking violations.

1. Guests will receive one reserve parking permit per a campsite.
2. Parking permits allow guests to park in designated parking areas. Having a permit does not guarantee you a parking space.
3. Parking Permits must be displayed in the front window of your vehicle. Vehicles without a visible parking permit may be towed at the owner's expense.
4. All school parking spaces are first come, first serve.
5. Parking on street in front of school is permitted. DO NOT block cross walks.
6. All parking areas will be marked by the school.
7. Do not block roads, side streets, alleys, or driveways. Obey all No parking areas.
8. Parking along the State Highway 30 is prohibited and violators will be cited and/or towed at the owner's expense.
9. The Huntington School District, its employees and students will not be held accountable for any items stolen from vehicles parked on school property. Lock your vehicles when left unattended.
10. The Huntington School District is not responsible for any damages to vehicles while parked on school district property.
